Children with Special Health Care Needs (CSHCN)

Children with special health care needs are children birth to 21 years of age who have or are suspected of having:

- chronic physical condition
- chronic developmental condition
- behavioral or emotional condition

The Children with Special Health Care Needs program provides information and referral services for health and related areas for families of children with special health care needs. The CSHCN program has a financial component, the Physically Handicapped Children's Program.

Physically Handicapped Children's Program (PHCP)

How is eligibility determined? Types of Services

To be considered for financial assistance one must be:

- under the age of 21
- live in Delaware County
- medically eligible

Each situation will be reviewed to determine the amount of assistance that may be provided.

Medical Eligibility

Some of the conditions covered include:

- Chronic Asthma
- Cancer
- Spina bifida
- Cystic Fibrosis
- Cerebral Palsy
- Convulsive Seizures
- Hearing Disorders
- Quadriplegia
- Paraplegia
- Orthopedic Problems



Aside from treatment, the Physically Handicapped Children's Program may also help pay for medical products which are necessities, including:

- Wheelchairs
- Braces and orthodontia supplies
- Hearing aids
- Diabetic supplies
- Medications
- and many more

In addition to financial help, the PHCP provides assistance in obtaining health services and community services.
